

What's new in Dolphin Aquarium 3.5

New Aquarium Features in 3.5

Add Annotations to Movies

You can now add annotations to movies. While the movie is playing, right-click anywhere in the movie to open the annotations menu. You can add text, rectangle and ellipse annotations. For each type of annotation, you can specify the pen color and style, font (for text) background color, size, and placement in the movie. See the online help for more information.

Built-in Versus Custom Audio

We now have icons to distinguish between media with built-in, non-changeable audio tracks, and media containing user-provided, custom audio:



for built-in audio



for custom audio

Additionally we added a new library, Has Audio, which contains all movies and stills that contain audio, whether built-in or custom.

Sort Media Thumbnails

We added a new control on the main screen, to the right of the add media control: the sort media control. Click it to open a list of options for sorting the media on the thumbnails group box. You can sort in ascending or descending order by Date Added or movie Name.

Mute and Volume Controls

We added a mute button and volume control to the Aquarium media player. These buttons appear on movies that contain audio.

Create New Playlist from a Thumbnail

You can now access the Add New Playlist dialog box, directly from the Media menu. Simply right-click on a thumbnail, and select Add to Playlist→Add New Playlist.

Sample Playlists

We now include more sample playlists for new customers or existing customers who have never created a custom playlist. These include new sample playlists for the Surgery-only module.

Licensing

As of the May 3.5 update, Aquarium will neither install nor run if you are using a USB dongle. If the installer senses a dongle, a message is displayed that directs you to a web form where you can set up an RMA for the dongle, and convert to Dolphin Licensing (DOLI) at no cost to you.

Closed Captioning

You can now add closed captions to Aquarium media. While playing a movie, there is a new **Caption** text box where you can input the desired text. You can specify the start time for each caption you add to a movie.

Additionally we added a new library, Has Caption, which contains all movies and stills that contain closed captioning.

New “Hamburger” Icon Menu

We replaced the “orb” menu with the more standard 3 bar “hamburger” menu.

Ability to Move Library Panel

You can now move the Aquarium Library panel (including Playlists, Treatments, and Diagnoses panels) to the right side of your screen. View→Right Side Panel.

Patient Context

You have been able to run Aquarium patient-in-context for the purpose of viewing patient-specific content; we added an option to deselect a patient to the File menu. File→Deselect Patient.

Played Content Report Improvements

You can now quickly replay media listed in the Played Content Report because the list includes hyperlinks to each movie played.

If you are running Aquarium with a patient in context, you can view played content for that patient only.

If your office is running Aquarium with Dolphin Imaging, Dolphin Management, or Dolphin Premium Utilities installed, you can view the Played Content Report for the logged-in employee only.

New Aquarium Features in 3.4

Turkish Language Support

This release of Aquarium includes Turkish language support. From the main menu, select Languages→Turk.

Italian Language Support

This release of Aquarium includes Italian language support. From the main menu, select Languages→Italiano.

New Default Skin: Material

Dolphin is rebranding itself with a new, unified look and feel, based on the Material Design industry standard. The new Aquarium skin, Material, is now the default skin when you launch Aquarium.

New Aquarium Features in 3.3

New Pediatric Dentistry Library

Included with this release of Aquarium is a new library, Dolphin Pediatric, containing movies specific to pediatric dentistry.

Media Count in Library List

Each Dolphin-provided library is now followed by its content count inside parentheses.

New Aquarium Features in 3.2

Foreign Language UI Support

You can now switch between various languages via the new Languages sub-menu. When you select a language other than English, the following are translated: user interface text, libraries, treatments, diagnoses, media names, and keywords. Additionally, you can enter text in the chosen language when adding new media, creating playlists, and searching for content.

Menu Reorganization

To improve clarity, we made several changes to the Aquarium menus, including:

- The General Preferences dialog box, previously accessible via Edit->General Preferences, has been renamed Options, and you can access it via Tools->Options.

- The Show Practice Logo menu option, previously under the View menu, has been moved to the Options dialog box, accessible via Tools->Options.
- The Tools->Module Activation menu option has been changed to Tools->Licensing.
- When you right-click in a blank space in the Libraries and Playlists group box, the New... option has been renamed to Add Playlist.
- The Import Playlist option now appears when you right-click on a blank space in the Libraries and Playlists group box.
- When you right-click a media thumbnail, the Cut and Copy options are included in the menu that appears.

Upload Aquarium Media to YouTube

When you export Aquarium Media, you now have the option to upload it to YouTube, using the new Upload to YouTube option on the Export Settings dialog box.

Sort Playlists Alphabetically

You can sort the list of playlist names in alphabetical order, or you can drag and drop them into any order you want. To have the list sorted alphabetically by default, on the Options dialog box, check Sort Playlists Alphabetically.

Library Changes

- We have reorganized and renamed the libraries in the Libraries and Playlists group box, and now All Dolphin Media is the default library.
- You can right-click on any library and make it the default.

Patient Lookup

If you have Dolphin Imaging or Dolphin Management installed, you can open the Patient Lookup dialog box by clicking on the new Patients button.

Pre-Backup Database

We have added a pre-backup capability. Pre-backup backs up your SQL database system, which stores your playlists, custom content, playback log, edited movies, etc., and saves it in your dolphin\working folder. You can check an option on the Options dialog box to ensure that pre-backups run automatically whenever you close Aquarium.

New Aquarium Features in 3.1

Media Sharing

Dolphin has a new product, My Orthodontist, which allows your practice to share information with patients on their smart phone or other mobile device. In addition to being able to share patient images from Dolphin Imaging, upcoming appointments, account balance, and questionnaires from Dolphin Management, you can share Aquarium playlists using the new Shared Media group. Even if you do not have My Orthodontist, you can use the Shared Media group to organize applicable media for that patient. Simply open Aquarium 3.1 from a patient screen in Dolphin Management or Dolphin Imaging, and the Shared Media library group shows up under the main Aquarium Library. Select the media you want to associate with the current patient, and copy it to the Shared Media list.

Easier Updates

When updating previous Aquarium releases, if you missed one or more updates, you had to install each update you missed individually in order to get all of the movies. Now if you miss one or more updates, you can simply

install the latest update, it checks to see which movies you need, and it installs them in the background once you launch Aquarium.

Search

We have changed the way the search feature works on the main Aquarium screen. In previous releases, it would pull up a list of the most frequently searched-for items that matched the keywords typed. Now it pulls up a list of the most recent searches that match the keywords typed.

New Skins

We have added 5 new color schemes to the Skins menu.

New Aquarium Features in 3.0

DOLphin Llcensing (DOLI)

Aquarium 2.0 licensing was provided on the purple Dolphin security key. Users upgrading from Aquarium 2.0 now have the option to switch to DOLI, which enables you to get your licenses through the Internet. New users get DOLI automatically. If you are an existing customer, and you want to switch to the new licensing, and turn in your purple security key, please contact Dolphin sales. Please note that in order to use DOLI, every computer in your network running Aquarium must be running version 3, and every computer running Dolphin Imaging must be running version 11.7. Dolphin Update Service (DUS) is still required.

Export Media

You can now export media individually or from a playlist directly to a DVD or USB drive that you can give to a patient to play on his or her home computer. The movie will be watermarked with your practice information for all use outside of the Aquarium program. You can now use drag and drop and cut and paste to export media out of Aquarium. Dolphin highly recommends you export all Aquarium media before using Drag and Drop or Cut, Copy, and Paste to export media. To access Cut and Copy, right-click on a movie or still, and select Edit | Cut or Edit | Copy. To paste a movie or a still, right-click, and select Paste. To access the Export dialog box, right-click a thumbnail, and select Export... from the menu.

Logging

Aquarium 3 logs which movies/stills are played, and whether they were played to completion or if they were started then stopped. Click Menu | View | Recently Played Report to see a report of all media played. You can then filter the report to include only those movies played to completion, or only movies played during a date range you define. Additionally, if you open Aquarium from within a patient screen in Dolphin Imaging or Dolphin Management, the log shows movies played for that patient only. The Aquarium library now includes a new group called Recently Played, which shows a thumbnail for each movie or still and the date and time it was played completely or started to play.

Arrange Playlists

Use drag and drop to arrange playlists in the order you want; previously they were always in alphabetical order.

Record Audio in Multiple Languages

You can define multiple languages for Aquarium- or user-provided media and then record customized audio in these languages. When you view Aquarium media there is a new language list box just below the media and above the horizontal scroll bar. The default language is English. To add more languages, simply mouse over that list box and click to bring up the Languages List dialog box. You can also use this feature to record different descriptions depending upon who your audience is.

Drag and Drop/Cut and Paste

You can now drag and drop media in and out of Aquarium; you can also use copy, cut, and paste to copy media out of or add media into Aquarium.

Multi-Select

Use Shift-click to select a group of thumbnails or Ctrl-click to select individual thumbnails and create a group that you can then play, copy, move to the hidden playlist, add to a new playlist, drag and drop, etc.

Movie Editor

Aquarium 3.0 comes with a simple movie editor that you can use to change the start and end time of each movie. The editor is easy to use, and it is equally easy to return to the original start and end time. For more information see the Dolphin Aquarium online help, and look up “editor” in the index.

Skins

You can now change the look of Aquarium during your Aquarium session. Simply select Menu | Skins and choose the color scheme you want to use.

Favorites

There is a new “Favorites” library group in Dolphin Aquarium. To add one or more movies or stills to the Favorites group, right-click on a movie and select “Add to Favorites.” You can also drag and drop or cut and paste media into the “Favorites” group.

General Preferences

By accessing the general preferences through Menu | File | General Preferences, you can specify the delay to use when looping. The default time is 2 seconds.

Add Practice Logo to Exported Movies

When you export movies out of Aquarium your practice logo is now exported and becomes part of the exported file.

Integrity Check

You can now check whether all the movies in your Aquarium installation are up-to-date by using the Menu |Tools | Check Media Integrity option.

Logo Display

You can now turn the logo display back on while playing a movie by right-clicking in the logo area and selecting Show Practice Logo While Playing Media from the menu.

Modeless Media Window

While a movie is playing, you can start another movie, perform searches, and access other Aquarium functions, where in Aquarium 2.0 you had to exit the media window before you could do this.

Drag Full Screen to another Monitor

When you start playing a movie in full-screen mode, you can drag the full screen to another monitor, and the presentation continues there.

Export Stills

Aquarium 3 supports exporting stills. Exported stills are in movie format, and they include your practice watermark. The still is displayed for the same amount of time it “plays” in Aquarium.
